Description

The event n. 9 represented the final event of the project with three main objectives:

- To present the final project results to partners and local stakeholders
- To discuss about project evaluation, follow up and project continuity
- To participate in the activities art performances, installations) organised by Imola Municipality.

1. Presentation of the project results

Each partner prepared during the past months a local art project that has been presented in the on line events and evaluated during the meeting in Croatia where a template for the presentation of the process and implementation of the art projects have been prepared. For each partner and each art project, an explanatory panels (200x100 cm) for a temporary exhibition in the Imola City Hall have been implemented and the exhibition has been opened to citizens on 25th April 2024. The digital formats of these printed panels have been uploaded on the project website. The panels will start a "local journey" in the secondary high schools on the Imola area and the exposition will be opened again for the Europe day on 9th May.

2. Seminar on evaluation and follow up

Partners representatives have had the opportunity to discuss about the process and results of the project and its impacts at local level. The focus was on three main questions:

- Has the project achieved the initial objectives set in the application?
- Can you identify some «gaps» that the project presented in order to transform them in «needs» for possible future projects, collaboration, exchanges?
- Do you have specific but shared topics on which you would like to work at transnational level to fill these gaps?
- How will the participation in this project contribute to the development of the involved organisations in the long-term? Do you have learnt a methodology, or discovered an element of your local community that you did not know before?
- Do you have any plans to continue using the results of the project?

The two discussion groups focused their attention on three main elements: the participative involvement of citizens at local level in implementing the art projects, the creation of a trustful European network, the methodology used based on participatory public art that can be transferred also in other local activities to increase community participation in activities.

3. Imola installations and participation of partners

Imola Municipality inaugurated its art project called "the empty plinth" where citizens and associations can express their opinions on the European values and rights. The project was linked to other installations and performances with local citizens within the local project called "quando un posto diventa un luogo" from which Art4rights project has been initiated.

Moreover, the experience of Imola has been presented thanks to a specific seminar on "when a place becomes heritage" with experts that introduces how the transformation of a space into a place can become a common and shared heritage element for citizens.

Partners directly participated in the installations expressing their thoughts on the topic.
